- 61** ⁴ Surely He has borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem Him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- 62** ⁵ But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon Him; and with His stripes we are healed.
- 63** ⁶ All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to His own way; and the LORD has laid on Him the iniquity of us all.
- 64** ⁷ He was oppressed, and He was afflicted, yet He opened not His mouth: He is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so He opened not His mouth.
- 65** ⁸ He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare His generation? for He was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was He stricken.
- 66** ⁹ And He made His grave with the wicked, and with the rich in His death; because He had done no violence, neither was any deceit in His mouth.
- 67** ¹⁰ Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief: when you shall make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, and the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand.
- 68** ¹¹ He shall see of the travail of His soul, and shall be satisfied: by His knowledge shall My righteous servant justify many; for He shall bear their iniquities.

Psalm 23

- 31** ¹ The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.
- 32** ² He makes me to lie down in green pastures: He leads me beside the still waters.
- 33** ³ He restores my soul: He leads me in the paths of righteousness for His name's sake.
- 34** ⁴ Indeed though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff they comfort me.
- 35** ⁵ You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies: You anoint my head with oil; my cup runs over.
- 36** ⁶ Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Psalm 1

- 37** ¹ Blessed is the man who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor stands in the way of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful.
- 38** ² But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law does he meditate day and night.
- 39** ³ And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that brings forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he does shall prosper.

- 40** ⁴The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind drives away.
- 41** ⁵Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.
- 42** ⁶For the LORD knows the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Get to know Jesus

- 43** John 14:6
Jesus said unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man comes unto the Father, but by Me.
- 44** John 1:1-14
¹In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God.
- 45** ²The same was in the beginning with God.
- 46** ³All things were made by Him; and without Him was not anything made that was made.
- 47** ⁴In Him was life; and the life was the light of men.
- 48** ⁵And the light shines in darkness; and the darkness comprehended it not.
- 49** ⁶There was a man sent from God, whose name was John.
- 50** ⁷The same came for a witness, to bear witness of the Light, that all men through Him might believe.

- 51** ⁸He was not that Light, but was sent to bear witness of that Light.
- 52** ⁹That was the true Light, which lights every man who comes into the world.
- 53** ¹⁰He was in the world, and the world was made by Him, and the world knew Him not.
- 54** ¹¹He came unto His own, and His own received Him not.
- 55** ¹²But as many as received Him, to them gave He power to become the sons of God, even to those who believe on His name:
- 56** ¹³Who were born, not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God.
- 57** ¹⁴And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, (and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,) full of grace and truth.
- 58** Isaiah 53:1-12
¹Who has believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the LORD revealed?
- 59** ²For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: He has no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see Him, there is no beauty that we should desire Him.
- 60** ³He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from Him; He was despised, and we esteemed Him not.
